

## CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT SkillsUSA North Dakota

The SkillsUSA North Dakota State Conference is designed to be an educational function and all plans are made with that objective. It is approved as a significant educational activity by the National Association of Trade and Industrial Education and the North Dakota Department of Career & Technical Education.

SkillsUSA North Dakota wants every person to have an enjoyable experience with maximum attention on safety and comfort. All participants will be expected to conduct themselves in a manner best representing the nation's greatest student organization.

In order that everyone may receive the maximum benefits from participation, the "Code of Conduct," as established by the National SkillsUSA Board of Directors must be followed at all times.

- 1. My conduct shall be the responsibility of the local SkillsUSA Association.
- 2. I will be prompt and prepared for all activities.
- 3. I will keep my Advisor(s) informed of my activities and whereabouts at all times.
- 4. I will wear identification badges/wristbands at all times.
- 5. I will not deface public property. (Any damages to property or furnishings in hotel rooms or buildings will be paid for by the individual or chapter responsible.)
- 6. I will spend each night in the room of the hotel/motel to which I am assigned.
- 7. I will strictly abide by the curfew established and shall respect the rights of others by being as quiet as possible after curfew. (Participants shall be in their respective rooms at 11:00 pm)
- 8. I will not use alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs in any form.
- 9. I will not remain in sleeping rooms with members of the opposite sex. Exceptions to this rule can be made by the SkillsUSA ND State Director or local chapter advisor for special meetings.
- 10. I will respect official SkillsUSA attire and not smoke while wearing it.
- 11. I will not leave the hotel/conference location unless permission from my Advisor/Director has been obtained.
- 12. I will attend, and be on time for, all sessions and activities that I am assigned to and registered for.
- 13. I will adhere to the dress code at all times.
- 14. I understand that I may be sent home at my own expense for violating any of these rules.
